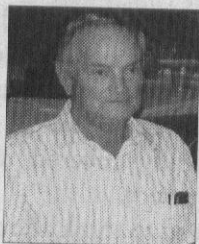


Robert A. Peltier

Robert "Bob" A. Peltier died in his home in Russia on Wednesday, Dec. 12, 2007 at the age of 83.



He was born to Zelma (Paulus) and Raymond Peltier of Russia, both deceased, on Feb. 17, 1924. On Sept. 10, 1947, he married Delores F. (Schlater) Peltier, who survives him.

Mr. Peltier is also survived by three sisters: Virginia Rosengarten of Fort Loramie, Norma Schlater of Fort Loramie and Ruth Millard of Cincinnati. He also leaves behind five children: Thomas (Nancy) Peltier of Akron, Gerald (Nancy) Peltier of Peachtree City, GA, Terri (Roger) Bay of Versailles, Jacque (Kelly) Peltier of Vandalia and Jan (Ron) Tipton of Grand Rapids, OH; as well as 12 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. He is preceded in death by two brothers, Leroy and Lester Peltier, and two sisters, Marie Ratermann and Wilma Schlater.

Mr. Peltier attended St. Remy Catholic Church in Russia and was a member of the St. Remy Knights of Columbus Council. He also previously served 10 years on the Russia Volunteer Fire Department. Mr. Peltier co-owned and operated Peltier's Garage in Russia with his brother Lester for 50 years, until retiring in 1986.

Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated on Saturday, Dec. 15, 2007 with Rev. Frank Amberger presiding.
