Joseph L. Pierron

Joseph L. Pierron died on Wednesday, Dec. 19 in his home in Osgood following an extended illness. He was 68.



Mr. Pierron was born Feb. 5, 1939 in Frenchtown as the son of Alfred and Treva (Treon) Pierron. On Sept. 30, 1961, he married Mary Bruggeman, who survives him.

He is also survived by his children Gary (Sandy) Pierron of Versailles, Bruce (Elaine) Pierron of Maria Stein and Nick (Amy) Pierron of Maria Stein as well as nine grandchildren.
