

Mrs. Holscher Passes; Rites Held Monday

Mrs. Clara E. Holscher, 72, RR, Yorkshire, near Osgood, died at 12:20 a.m. last Friday at her home, after an illness of 13 months due to cancer and paralysis.

She was born May 8, 1892, at Fort Laramie and had spent her entire life in the area. Her parents were the late Bernard and Elizabeth Dressman Poeppelman. She was married April 20, 1915, to Fred Holscher and he died October 19, 1964.

Mrs. Holscher was a member of St. Nicholas Catholic Church and the St. Barbara Married Ladies, and was a Gold Star Mother of World War II, her son Edward having lost his life in 1943.

Surviving are nine children, Mrs. Henry (Matilda) Pleiman, Osgood; Mrs. Donald (Rosemary) Homan, Coldwater; Urban, Joseph, Robert and Wilfred, all at home; Leo and Alfred, both of Osgood; and Raymond, Newport. There are 18 grandchildren and two brothers, Frank and Fred Poeppelman, both of Osgood.
