Leo A. Rosenbeck, 83, of Coldwater, died Wednesday, May 28, 2003 in St. Rita's Medical Center, Lima.

Mr. Rosenbeck was born Aug. 16, 1919 in Coldwater, the son of the late William and Rosa Selhorst Rosenbeck. He married Victoria Zink, Oct. 26, 1948. she survives.
