Raymond Joseph Schwieterman, 89, formerly of 128 Dull Rd., St. Henry, died Dec. 7, 2002 at the Gardens of St. Henry.

Mr. Schwieterman was born Aug. 22, 1912 in St. Sebastian, the son of the late Charles and Caroline Will Schwieterman. He married Bertha R. Bruening in North Star. She preceded him in death, April 16, 1992.
