Raymond H. Wuebker

Raymond H. Wuebker, 80, 121 E. Main St. St. Henry, died Sunday, Sept. 28, 2003 in Community Hospital, Coldwater.

Mr. Wuebker was born Oct. 25, 1922 in Carthagen, the son of the late John and Helena Selhorst Wuebker.

He married Mildred Goette-moeller May 31, 1949 in St. Henry. She survives.

Other survivors include sons Mike (June) of Minster, Tom (Vicki) of St. Henry, and Fred (Kelly) of Lima; daughters Elaine (Bruce) Seger of Fort Loramie and Mary Ann (Dan) Hemmelgarn of St. Henry; and 14 grandchildren.

Mr. Wuebker was a member of St. Henry Church. He belonged to the St. Henry Knights of Columbus, the Maria Stein Knights of St. John, the American Legion in St. Henry and the Coldwater VFW.

He was a WWII Army Veteran.

Mr. Wuebker was the former owner and operator of the Wuebker Pennzoil in St. Henry and he

was also retired from Avco New Idea Corp. in Coldwater.
