

Boldman anniversary at Huntington Beach

Dr. and Mrs. Ron and Brenda Boldman of Troy will be celebrating their 50th wedding anniversary on Oct. 25, 2008.

The Boldmans were married in the Presbyterian Church in Troy in 1958. Ron was a graduate of Christianburg High School and later went on to graduate from the Tennessee Temple University of Chattanooga in their school of theology. Brenda, a graduate of Troy High School, graduated from the Christ Hospital School of Nursing in Cincinnati.

Dr. Boldman founded and pastored Calvary Chapel Baptist Church and Maranatha Academy in Minster, pastoring in Minster for 12 years. In 1982, the Boldmans ventured to southern California where Dr. Boldman pastored Central Baptist Church and First Baptist Church of San Antonio Heights for the remaining 35 years of his ministry. Mrs. Boldman followed her nursing career in home health, gerontology and hospice. Dr. Boldman also served as Lt. Col. chaplain in the U.S. army for 26 years.



The Boldmans are now retired, living in the Branson, MO area, where he is the associate pastor of the Branson Sunday Gospel Church and she does substitute school nursing for two elementary schools in the Branson area. the Los Angeles area with their families; and Aaron also resides in the Branson area with his family. There are 16 grandchildren: 12 grandsons and four granddaughters.
