floor-length gown with sheer sleeves and neckine, accented with black rhinestones.

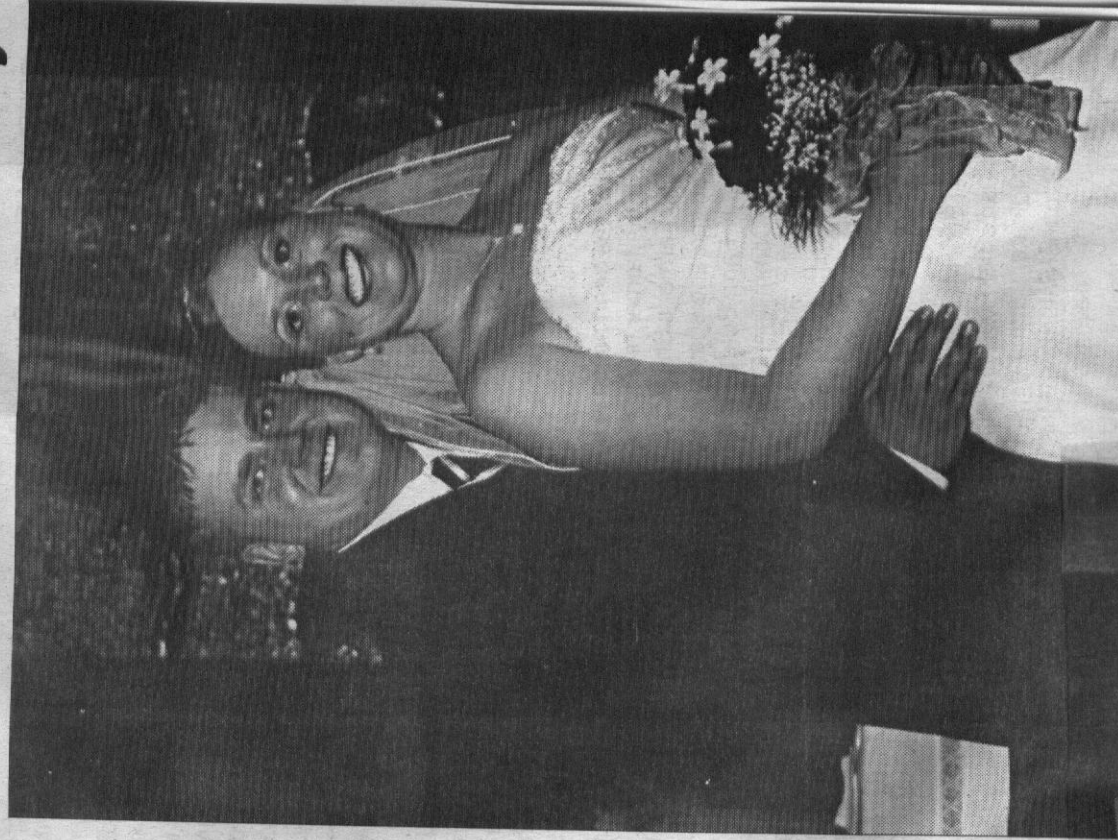
