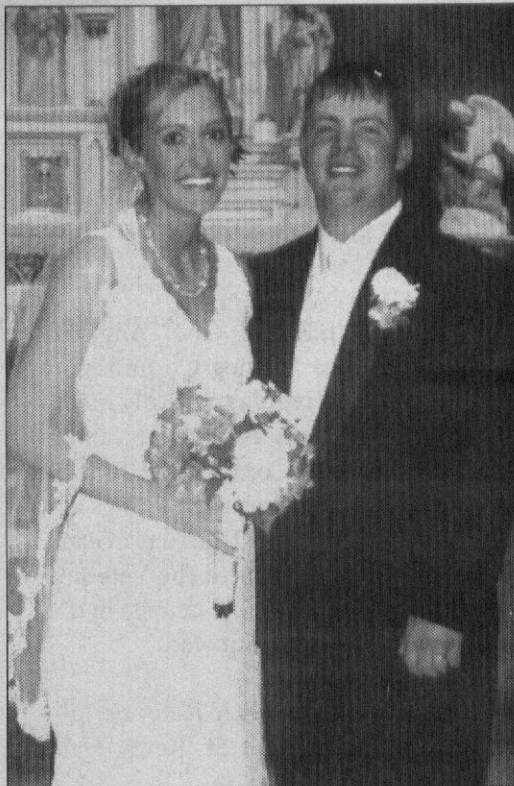
Music was provided by organist Doris Wilker and vocalists Candy Hemmelgarn and Jeanette Meyer.
