astromeria.

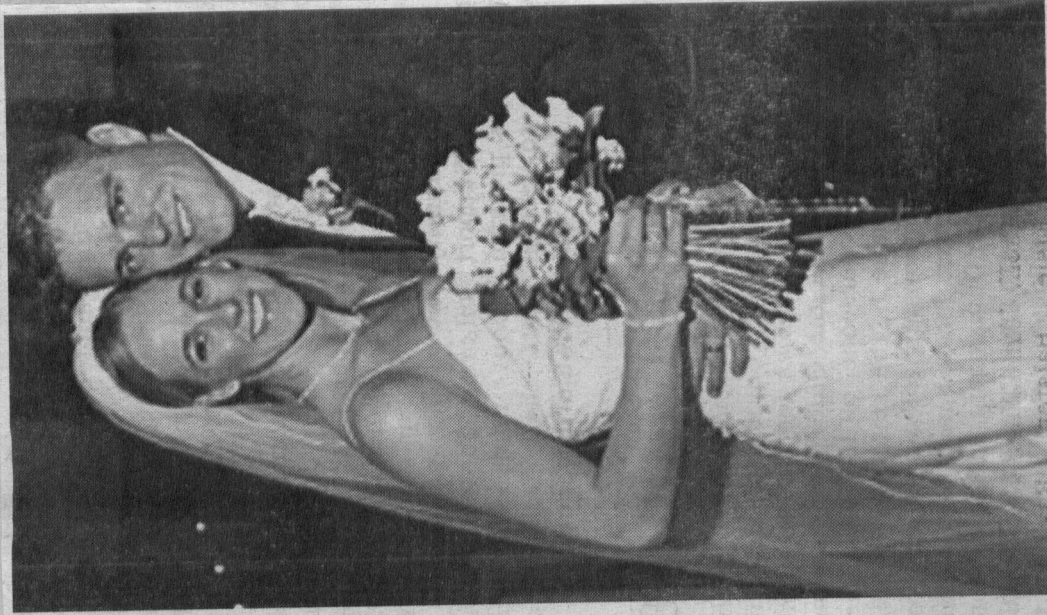
Grandparents are Vera Woehrmyer, grandmother of the bride and Irma Hoying, grandmother of the groom.
